What is FMTS?

- ✓ A review of medical and educational needs for family members of an active duty Service Member
- ✓ A requirement for families being considered for a remote or an overseas assignment
- ✓ A process to ensure identified family needs are considered

What is the FMTS Pilot?

- ✓ A test of new FMTS forms across designated military installations, standard for all Services
- ✓ A trial use of standardized medical and educational screening forms
- ✓ An opportunity to identify additional improvements to the FMTS process

Why is the Pilot occurring?

- ✓ To improve consistency of service and enhance the family experience
- ✓ To standardize and streamline medical and educational screening forms for the FMTS process
- ✓ To assist families, particularly at joint base and sister-Service installations
